RESOLUTION NO. 2019 - 01

RE: AMENDMENT OF RULES & REGULATIONS RE: METRO WASTEWATER RECLAMATION DISTRICT CONNECTION FEES and DISTRICT CONNECTION FEES

WHEREAS, on June 15, 2018, the Board of Directors of the Metro Wastewater Reclamation District adopted a resolution which sets the Sewer Connection Charge for 2019 at \$4,270.00.00 per Single Family Residential Equivalent (SFRE) effective on January 1, 2019; and

WHEREAS, the Metro Wastewater Reclamation District has powers under §32-1-1001(1)(j), C.R.S. to set its fees and rates from time to time; and

WHEREAS, said resolution will change the Metro Connection Fees as set forth in Appendix B to the Applewood Sanitation District Rules and Regulations; and

WHEREAS, the District collects connection fees on behalf of both the District and the Metro Wastewater Reclamation District (“Metro”); and

WHEREAS, the Board, after considerable discussion, determined that, in the interests of keeping the District financially sound, it was necessary to increase its Connection Fees, effective January, 1, 2019; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of Applewood Sanitation District that Appendix B be amended to reflect the change in the Metro Connection Fees and the District Connection Fees.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Directors of the Applewood Sanitation District that the updated fees and charges depicted in the District rules and regulations - Appendix B, attached to this resolution, shall be imposed effective January 1, 2019.

No payment by May 1 of respective calendar year will result in a lien being placed on the property and legal costs in the amount of \$113 being added to the amount due. No payment by October 1 of respective calendar year results in certification of the delinquent account, including an additional \$120 certification fee, to the Jefferson County Treasurer for collection with ad valorem taxes.

(b) Annual Non-Residential Sewer Services Charge

- (1) Non-residential sewer service charges shall be assessed at \$350 per equivalent residential rate, based upon the domestic water consumption for the previous year, less allowances for proven landscaped areas.
- (2) Non-Residential Delinquency Charges: No payment in full of invoiced amounts within 60 days of due date will result in the imposition of a \$185 delinquency charge and certification to the Jefferson County Treasurer for collection with ad valorem taxes of any outstanding amounts.
